Our Policy

NCFIE uses its best effort to respect the privacy of its online visitors. In general, when you visit our Website and access information, you remain anonymous. This means that we do not collect personally identifiable information from individuals unless they provide it to us voluntarily and knowingly. We do not require you to register or provide information to us in order to view our site. NCFIE only gathers personally identifiable data, such as names, addresses, zip/postal codes, e-mail address, etc., when voluntarily submitted by a visitor. For example, personally identifiable information may be collected in order to respond to a stated desire to make a financial donation online. This information is used for internal purposes solely by NCFIE or other entities that are involved in the operation of this site. NCFIE lists are never sold to third parties. We will only share personally identifiable information with third parties when (i) the person submitting the information authorizes us to share it; (ii) sharing the information is a necessary

operation of the site, for instance, to process a credit card transaction; or (iii) we are required by law. NCFIE has no control over or responsibility for the data collection and use practices of third parties.

Is Credit Card Information Secure?

We care about the safety and security of your transaction. Our merchant services provider uses high grade encryption and the https security protocol to communicate with your browser software. In addition to maintaining privacy and security controls over information you share with us, NCFIE works to accurately process your information. NCFIE employs error checking procedures to make certain transactions are processed completely and accurately. As necessary, changes are made to improve our systems and independent, external and internal audits are conducted to ensure the privacy, security and appropriate processing of your information on our site.

How Do We Use “Cookies”?

Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data may be automatically collected by the NCFIE Website through the use of “cookies.” “Cookies” are small text files a Website can use to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate the visitors’ ongoing access to and use of the site, and allow a site to track usage behavior and compile aggregate data that will allow content improvements. Cookies are not programs that come onto a visitor’s system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. NCFIE uses “cookie” technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve visitors’ online experience and facilitate their visit within our site.
